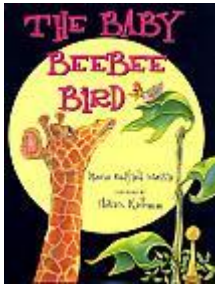


## Silly Stories



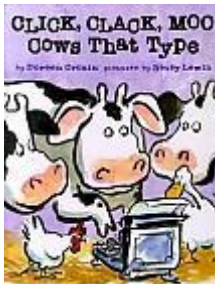
[\*The Baby BeeBee Bird\*](#) by Diane Massie.

When Farmer Brown's cows find a typewriter in the barn they start making demands and go on strike when the farmer refuses to give them what they want.



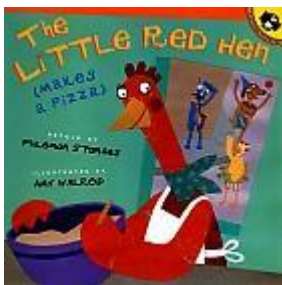
**Smash! Crash!** by Jon Scieszka.
